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KEY FINDINGS



The 2021-22 Cambodia Demographic and Health Survey (CDHS) provided data to collect data and understand the prevalence of intimate partner violence and disability in the Royal Kingdom of Cambodia.

The survey is based on a nationally representative sample. It provides estimation at the national and provincial levels, as well as for urban and rural areas.



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Intimate partner violence

21% of women age 15-49 who ever had experienced emotional, physical or sexual violence committed by their current or most recent husband/intimate partner

The most prevalent physical violence of intimate partner was stated to be being pushed, shook, or having something thrown at them, and being slapped by 6% of women, in each of its category.

The most prevalent emotional violence of intimate partner was stated to be insulting or making her feel awful about herself by 16% of women.

The most prevalent sexual violence of o intimate partner was stated to forcing to have sexual intercourse when she did not want to by 2% of women.
