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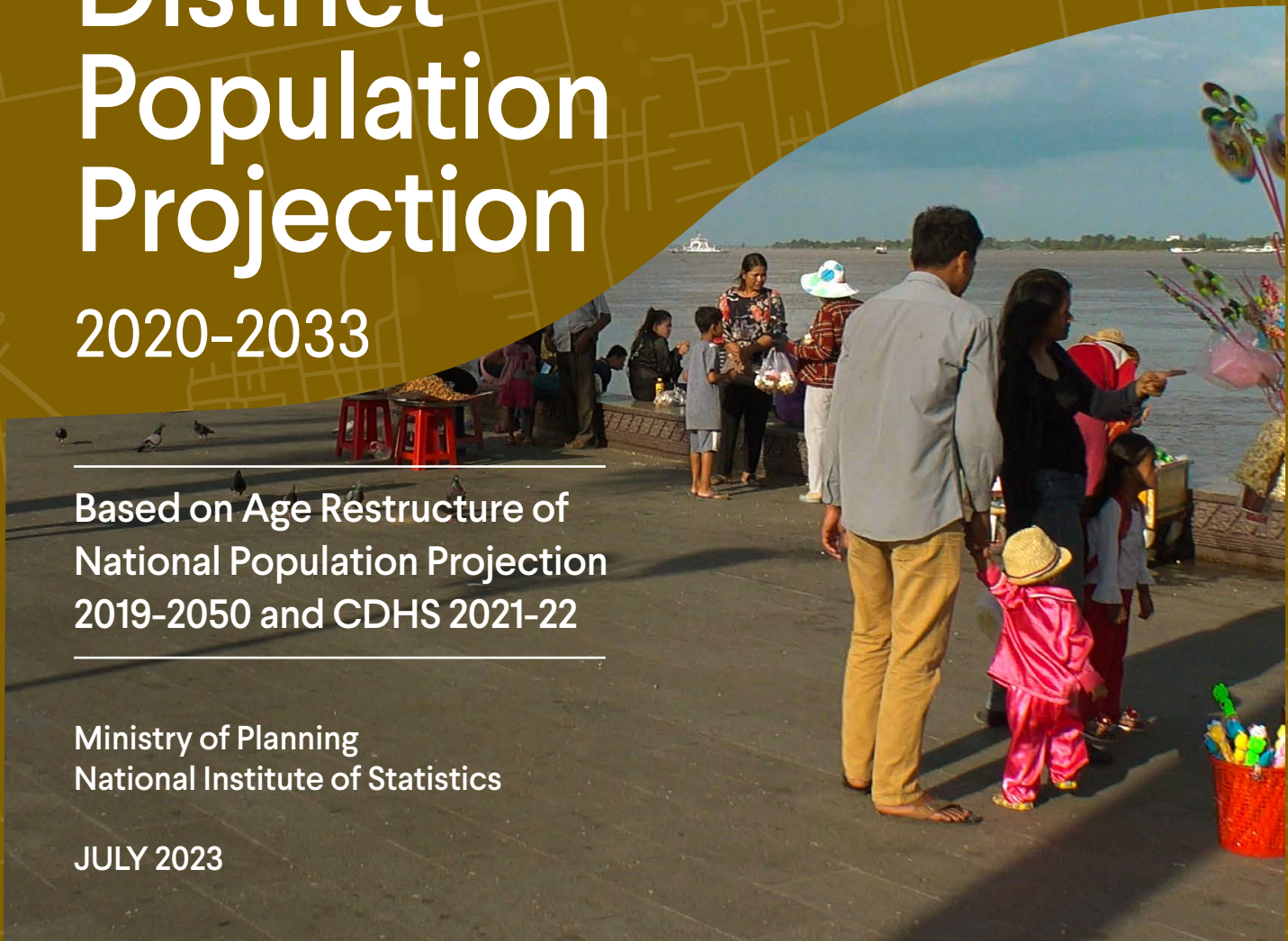

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Foreword

This population data presents the "Population Projections for Cambodia 2020 to 2033" at district level using results from the Series of Thematic Report on Population Projection based on General Population Census of Cambodia 2019 as well as the Cambodia Demographic and Health Survey (CDHS) 2021/22. This projection exercise was undertaken by the National Institute of Statistics (NIS) in collaboration with Ministry of Health and Vital Strategies.

The results include population projections at district level aggregated population by sex and age groups, and summary of some demographic indicators based on health indicators from Ministry of Health. The year boundary for projections is set from 2020 to 2033.

On behalf of the National Institute of Statistics, Ministry of Planning, I would like to express my gratitude and appreciation to Vital Strategies for their technical and financial support to produce this Population Projection data for all district as reference for use as need by stakeholders. 1. Introduction

Population projection is a scientific attempt to peep into the future population conditioned by making certain assumptions, using data relating to the past available at that point of time. Assumptions used and their probability of adhering in future, forms a critical input in this mathematical effort. Predicting the future course of human fertility and mortality is not easy, especially when looking beyond in time as medical and health intervention strategies, food production and its equitable availability, climatic variability, socio-cultural setting, politico economic conditions and a host of other factors influence population dynamics, making it difficult to predict the growth with certainty. Therefore, caution must be exercised while making or using the population projections in the context of various conditions imposed.

The appropriate method to do this is to prepare estimates and projections of population size and structure by age and sex. The starting point for any projections is a reliable age-sex distribution of a population. Furthermore information on recent levels and patterns of fertility, mortality, and migration is needed. The cohort-component method is the most scientific and reliable method of population projections. This procedure simulates population changes as a result of changes in the components of growth: fertility, mortality, and migration. Based on past information, assumptions are made about future trends in these components of change. The assumed rates are applied to the age and sex structure of the population, in a simulation that takes into account that people die according to their sex and age that women have children, and some people change their residence. The cohort-component method of projecting a population follows each cohort of people of the same age and sex throughout their lifetime according to their exposure to fertility, mortality, and migration. This projection carried out for 13-year period; 2020-33. The key to making meaningful projections lies in the choice of assumptions about future population developments. These assumptions concern possible future birth, death, and migration rates. In general, when preparing multiple assumptions about future levels of fertility, mortality and/or migration, it is advisable to arrive at outcomes that are symmetric.

2. Objective

The purpose of this population projection to fulfill the APW in order to prepare an updated, officially endorsed set of population projections, at national and provincial levels, for the

period 2020 – 2033 with age and sex breakdown consistent with the subpopulations of interest to the Ministry of Health (MoH).

3. Methodology

There are several computer programs designed to calculate projections with this method (see, for example, DemProj, Mortpak, DAPPSi). The present projection was conducted using the software Rural-Urban Projections (RUP), developed by the U.S. Bureau of the Censusⁱⁱ. One of the main advantages of this software is that it allows projections by single years of age (instead of five-years as the conventional approach). Data for special age groups that do not fall into conventional five-year age groups can be obtained with this feature. It also makes it possible to follow population cohorts that may be smaller or larger than adjacent cohorts due to past demographic events. In addition, the projection is executed year by year. By using this feature, it is possible to add information on demographic events for a particular year without forcing the effect over a five-year period. It is important to mention that it makes available estimates for each year without having to interpolate between data for intermediate years. Input data for the population and components can be provided in either single years or five-year age groups. The age grouping of each item is independent, so it is possible to input five-year data for some items and single-year data for others. The program converts all data set to single years of age before executing the projection (Arriaga and associates, 1994). This flexibility has the advantage of allowing a demographer to develop a projection model that accurately captures the demographic situation of a country and makes maximum use of available data in a way that is as close as possible to its original form. The program provides outputs on diverse demographic measures for any given year within the projection period such as population by age and sex (single years, 5-years age groups, and special age groups), summary measures, summary vital rates, life tables, migration rates, number of births and death, etc. ⁱⁱⁱ.

The notion of analytical credibility is central to any projection exercise. The assumptions regarding the components must be between the limits of credibility suggested by the characteristics of the country, its past demographic trends, the experience of other countries and the available demographic knowledge.

In population projections it is commonplace to assume that the country will not be affected by a war, a natural disaster or a catastrophic economic crisis. Although it is possible to develop simulation exercises to analyze the demographic effects of disasters, violence and economic crisis, a conventional population projection assumes that the current situation will not suffer any serious disruptions in the future. This is not to say that no attempts are made to allow for future socioeconomic changes. Implicitly or explicitly, they are taken into account in the constructions of the hypotheses regarding the components.

◆ **Age and Sex Structure:** The results age and sex structure information from General Population Census of Cambodia (GPCC) 2019 have been used to project the size of the future population by age and sex for many years into the future. The results include population projections of national level and its provincial aggregated by sex five-year age groups and summary of some demographic indicators. The projections been predicted from 2020 to 2033.

◆ Predict Fertility and Mortality

Mortality change (and fertility change) are processes where new behavior is gradually being adopted by people. It is similar to the processes of a new product penetrating a market. In other words: A **diffusion process**. Diffusion processes are often modeled by a **logistic function**.

Fertility level: The TFR of Cambodia have rapid declines in fertility and mortality, as well as substantial internal migration, have occurred since 2008, as demonstrated by the results of the Cambodian Demographic and Health Surveys (CDHS) 2010 and 2014 and the results of the NIS's Census 2019.

Using the spreadsheet interpolates and extrapolates total fertility rates (TFRLGST) developed by U.S. bureau of the census international programs center population analysis spreadsheets (PAS). The program fits a logistic function using 2 to 7 total fertility rates, given the values of upper and lower asymptotes. The fertility rates, given the values of upper and lower asymptotes. The beginning date for displaying the results is also entered.

The census data utilized in order to compute these measures was the number of births by age of the mother during the 12 months prior to the census and the number of children ever born alive, also by age of women. As in the case of mortality, indirect demographic methods were used to get reliable estimates of these fertility measure (see Fertility Thematic Paper). According to the 2019 Census, TFR in Cambodia is 2.5 children per woman.

After theoretical and empirical considerations, it was decided that TFR will follow an exponential trend in the future. This trend is consistent with the observed past decline and it assumes that in the near future fertility will continue declining but at a progressively slower pace. Notice that the TFR estimated for 1998 (from the census) was not included in the calculation of the exponential function.

For these projections the program E0LGST from the set of Excel demographic programs PAS was used to project life expectancy at birth. Three pieces of information are necessary: a lower asymptote, which is the historical lowest life expectancy at birth, an upper asymptote which is the highest possible life expectancy at birth. Between these two extremes the three census estimates were used. This operation is done separated for males and females.

◆ **Migration:** Making meaningful assumptions about future migration developments provides the single greatest difficulty for undertaking population projections, as many of the social and economic parameters shaping migration patterns depend largely on countries' overall social, economic and political developments, which can fluctuate widely and are hard to predict. It, furthermore, depends on economic and political developments overseas, in particular on decisions whether or not to provide working or residency visas, and/or establish immigration quotas for potential (labour) migrants.

Based on the migration data of General Population Census of Cambodia (GPCC) 2019, inter-provinces net migrants during decade 2020-2033 has been assumed to remain constant throughout the projection periods. The component of international migration has been assumed to be negligible then assumed as 0.

◆ **Estimate Population by Age Group**

An estimate the population in according to the age requirement from MoH at province and subnprovince each year are based on national population projection 2019-2033 conducted by National Institute of Statistics. The conversion of the 5-years age groups population into single ages according to Beers formulas.

- First is to convert the five-year age groups population into single year's age for each year and location by using the Beers formulas (Beers, 1945).
- Second restructure age in according to age group as per requirement from MoH stated in ToR.
- Using Spectrum to capture the summary population projection by selected indicators

◆ **Estimate Infant by Age Group**

An estimate infant born by age group using three year moving average of infant born three years preceding survey CDHS 2021-22 classified by age and sex and assume there was constant in infant born during the projection period.

◆ **Estimate Pregnancy by Age Group**

The expected pregnant women are calculated by adjust between the General Fertility Rate (GFR), Fetal Loss Rate (FLR) in CDHS report table Table 8.4 chapter 8, Total Induced

Abortion Rate (TAR) Table 5.15 chapter 5 and currently teenage pregnant Table 5.12 chapter 5 of CDHS 2021-22.

◆ Estimate Married Women by Age Group

An estimate married women by age group using the age specific married rate and the annual exponential population growth during the previous three census and CDHS 2021-22 then applied with the women in age specific group to get the married women during the projection period.

4. Result

The Spectrum program converted all data set to single years of age before executing the projection. This flexibility has the advantage of allowing a demographer to develop a projection model that accurately captures the demographic situation of a country and makes maximum use of available data in a way that is as close as possible to its original form. The program provides outputs on diverse demographic measures for any given year within the projection period such as population by age and sex.

Data for special age groups of five-year age groups to be projected using the components method of Spectrum Software to provide in either single years or five-year age groups. It also makes it possible to follow population cohorts that may be smaller or larger than adjacent cohorts due to past demographic event.

Population projections at sub-national level, is important because Cambodia is administratively divided into 24 provinces and a metropolitan area corresponding to Phnom Penh, the capital-city. The projection of the population by age and sex for each of this sub-division was conducted. This exercise is considered of crucial importance.

A key concept to response this question is that of Regional Planning. It is the planning directed to the design of plans and programs that consider the specific characteristics of sub-areas. It should match national with local development and, what is more important; it should generate national development through the progress in the local areas. The size, structure and dynamic of the population in different local areas are vital inputs to regional planning activities.

It is well known that population projections in local areas are less reliable and certain than those prepared for national projections. This is primarily the consequence of the problems related to projecting internal migration. This is usually the most important component of population changes among local areas. Hence, a major problem in population projections among subareas is the projection of internal migration.

For this reason, sometime is better to use mathematical or ratio models to project the population in local areas. Consequently, a method based on a contingency table adjustment was utilized for this projection. This table utilizes “two-way raking” or iterative proportional fitting.

The contingency table is designed to adjust local populations by age to the total population also by age. The sum of the input totals for the subpopulations does not have to match the input country total. This table proportionally adjusts the subpopulation totals to add to the country total as well as to adjusted totals by subarea. Although originally designed to adjust populations by age, the workbook is also used for projections. The provincial population (by age groups) for year n is adjusted to add the total population (by age groups) of year $n+1$. The adjusted provincial population is then the projected population.

The Excel spreadsheet CTBL32, in the set of demographic programs PASXX iterative proportional fitting method have been used for population projection at district level.
